The autism family retreat camp is a 4 day family vacation in an environment where autism is understood and supported.

Our focus is on helping kids on the autism spectrum participate in camp activities that are a part of every kid's life and to provide a place where families can vacation with ease and make positive memories together.



In addition, we will have hands on workshops on natural treatments, sensory integration therapy, gluten-free cooking, and horse therapy for developmental delays.

Activities and amenities of the camp week:

- outdoor play (including ropes/balancing course, volleyball, trails, softball fields, treehouse, and creek)
- full indoor gymnasium
- crafts
- horse therapy workshop
- canoeing/kayaking on small lake
- pond swimming (with lifeguards on duty)
- campfires at night
- singing
- gluten free/dairy free menu
- gluten free cooking class
- sensory integration demonstration and instruction
- behavioral techniques in the home: discussion
- autism and treatments: discussion
- family game time
- fishing
- optional additions for siblings not on the autism spectrum: day camp or horse camp
